Rules

1. Start collecting pledges as soon as you receive your packet. Inside are pledge sheets and the envelope is to keep your pledge money in.
2. Pledges may be made by anyone. Any amount helps!
3. Each person making a pledge should write their own name, total pledge, cash or check and date paid. Collect the pledge in advance as they sign up and keep all cash and checks in the envelope to turn in.
4. On Walk-A-Thon day, Saturday, July 31, the walk begins at 8:00 AM sharp. We will meet at the Administrative Offices of Henry County Board of Education, located at 33 N. Zack Hinton Parkway, McDonough starting at 7:30 am. It is a 1.2 mile course from the Administrative Offices to the McDonough Square and back.
5. Please return your pledge sheets and envelope with money to Ricky Craig by Wednesday, July 28. Bring other pledges the day of the walk.
6. We walk rain or shine. Participants are encouraged to wear hats and sunscreen if it's sunny or bring rain gear if it's rainy.
7. The organizers of this event have chosen not to give out t-shirts or prizes for most money collected, etc. 100% will go to People First.
